Delta Dental will stop taking its allotment at the end of the year so if you want to continue with dental coverage you must sign up for a carrier. VA Choice program is fully funded for a year to enable going to a provider outside the network. Appeal process for denied claims is being streamlined to fast track it.

**Scorecard Review:** Col David Patrick, USAF (Ret) – Scorecard reviewed. Elimination of 3 year renewal may defer need for dues increase for another year as suggested in 4.4. Priority 5 – Austin, TMOA is not interested in being a partner. Need a side meeting to develop a strategy or a decision.
