Committee reports

Cemetery Committee— The cemetery main gate will reopen in May in time for Memorial Day, and construction of the bridge over Nursery Road will start then. The only entrance to the cemetery will be thru the checkpoint on Winans Road at the cemetery maintenance shop gate. Policy on admittance is being formulated now for those without an ID card. Unfinished Business: Missing in America has identified six veteran cremains in Amarillo, and they will be escorted by the Patriot guards from city to city to San Antonio for a mass burial. The date will be April at 1000 hrs, at the cemetery, at the assembly area. Governor Abbott and Mayor Ivy have been invited to attend. MacArthur High School Army JROTC will provide a colorguard color guard. There are 92 cremains still left in Amarillo, not identified as veterans, and There are still 17,000 unclaimed remains in the nation. Those identified as veterans will be hopefully referred to Missing in America for assistance in burial.

New Business: Vetrerans Day parade- need time, date, truck, trailer, chairs. Have some decorations.
